The annual dues shall be based upon four-hundredths of one per cent (.04%) operation expenditures as defined in the Washington Public Library Statistics (exclusive of construction and one-time funds) of the library for the previous year within the following limits:	The annual dues for academic and special libraries shall be based on the total annual operating expenditures of the library for the previous year, as follows: (Formula: \$200, plus \$2.00 for each additional \$10,000 of annual operating expenditures or fraction thereof over \$150,000 to a maximum of \$500.00).
